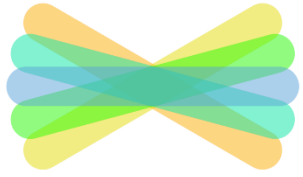




Seesaw

What is Seesaw?



Seesaw is a virtual learning platform.

It is like an online learning book - a place for your child to share their learning with their teacher and with you.

Seesaw is a safe and secure platform which is GDPR compliant.

When logged in, children can only see their own learning and are only able to interact with their teachers. All posts and comments must be approved by a teacher.

Teachers see all stages of student thinking and progress – enabling them to teach better

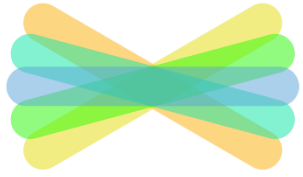

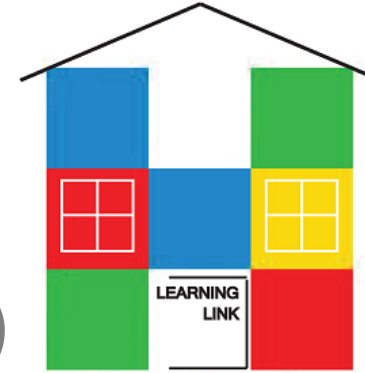

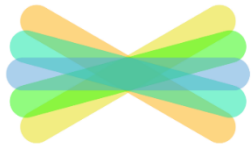
Families gain a window into their student's learning and engage in home-to-school connections

Why use Seesaw?



- Learning at school
- Learning links at home (as needed)
- Online safety - a safe environment to learn how to use the internet
- Develops independence
- Preparation for using technology appropriately
- Develop learning concepts through engagement with technology





How to use Seesaw

- Receive letter with instructions and QR code. The QR code is a password.
- On a computer: <https://app.seesaw.me>
- On a phone or tablet: Install the Seesaw Class App
- Use the QR code or the letters to log in
- Turn on notifications
- Wait to be notified of any activities to complete or announcements

Example Student's Home Learning Code

1. Go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer. Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS or Android device.



2. Choose "I'm a Student".



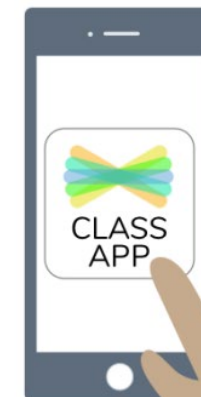
3. Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account: **LZNG STSD DPG CFPB**



Ask your teacher for a new code after November 1, 2022.

This code is a password. If you have this code, you can access this account. Do not post codes on social media or in any publicly accessible place on the internet!

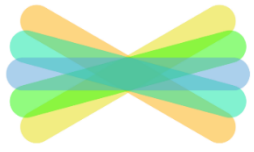

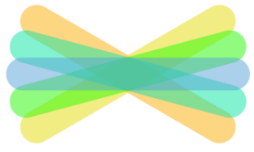

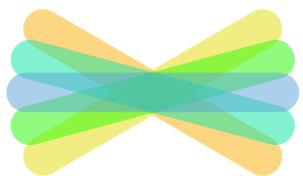


How to use Seesaw
