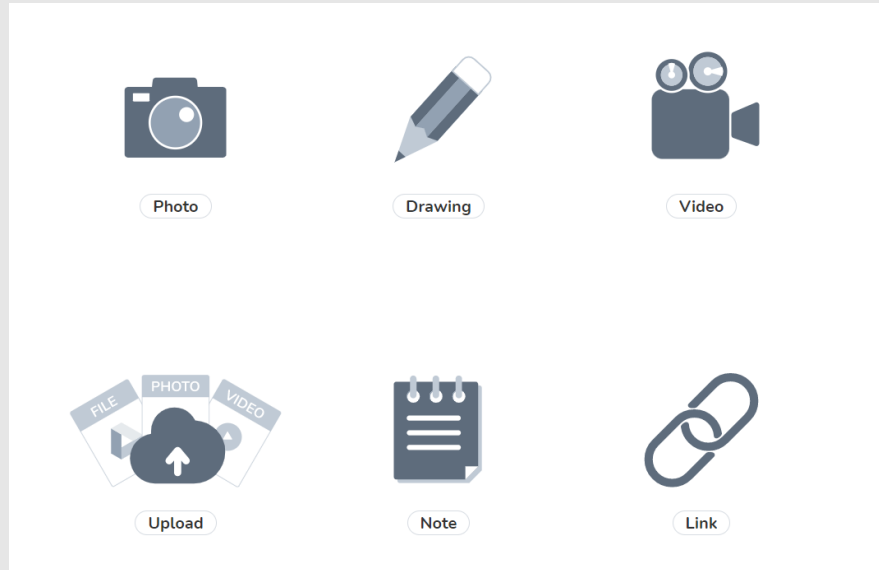

What is SeeSaw?



- SeeSaw is an interactive platform that can help students learn.
- It does not replace hands on learning but seamlessly runs alongside to consolidate learning within the classroom.
- Students using SeeSaw are encouraged to collaboratively share their work in a digital environment.
- Students are encouraged to “share what they know” and SeeSaw enables them to do this in a range of ways.

- Teachers find or create activities to share with students.
- Students use creative tools to take pictures, draw, record videos and more to capture learning in a portfolio.


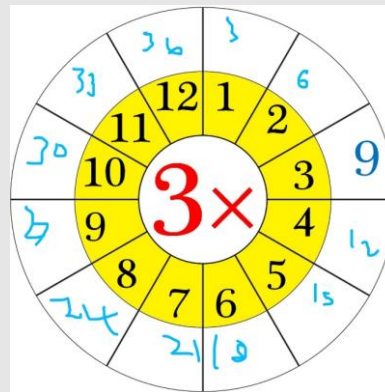


